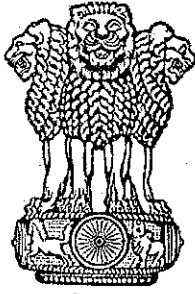

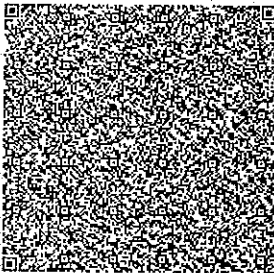

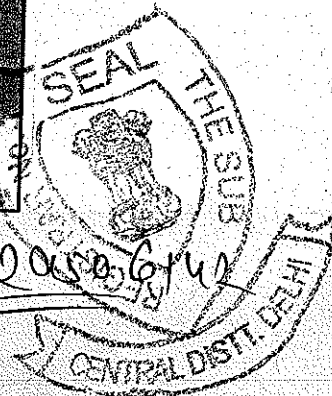

"ANISHA CHARITABLE TRUST (ACT)"

This Deed of Public Trust made at Delhi on 15th Sep 2014 by Mrs. Gunja Singh W/o Sh. Aditya Kumar Naveen, aged about 29 years R/o RZ-2910, 3rd Floor, Gali No- 32, Tughlakabad Ext, Aali, South Delhi-110019 (Hereinafter referred to as the **"SETTLER/MANAGING TRUSTEE"** which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to include the survivors, his / her heirs, executors and assigns).

WHEREAS the Author is desirous of creating a Public Trust and whereas in pursuance of this desire, has this day created a Public Trust, Under this instrument detailing herein the objects of the Trust, its powers, the manner in which the Trust is to function and other such details as are necessary for the proper functioning of the Trust.

FOR THIS PURPOSE, SETTLER is desirous of setting a sum of **Rs. 1100./-** (**Rs One Thousand One Hundred Only**) to settle a TRUST to be named as **ANISHA CHARITABLE TRUST (ACT)** for undertaking to provide all kind of support and help, both in cash and kind towards educating the people of India to stand up for their rights and providing them food on regular basis, conservation of the human and ensure its rightful place in the Indian culture as India's national.

AND WHERE AS THE TRUST DEED is now being executed by said SETTLER with present TRUSTEES and present TRUST DEED have agreed to execute these presents as testified their being parties to and executing these presents.

1. NAME AND CONSTITUTION OF THE TRUST-

- a) The settler does hereby declare and constitute the trust which shall be known as **ANISHA CHARITABLE TRUST (ACT)**, here in after referred to as the "Trust" with the object and constitution and the terms and condition of the trust as set forth here under.
- b) REGISTERED OFFICE:-The registered office of the Trust shall be in Delhi and shall be at present C-7/80,-81,SF, Sec-8, Rohini, Opposite-B-6 DDA Market, New Delhi-110085 which may be moved time to time to such other place or places as the trustees may deem fit and proper at their discretion.

2. INCOME & ASSETS AND FUNDS OF THE TRUST:-

- A) The Trustees hereby declare that they stand possessed of the said sum of Rs.1, 100/- only paid to them by the settler in trust for and as Trustees for the said trust on the date hereof day of Sep 2014.
- B) The Trustees do hereby agree and undertake to hold the assets that have been given and that may be hereafter given to them or may come into their hands as such trustees of the Trust and subject to the provisions here in contained.
- C) The sum of Rs. 1,100/- (Rupees one thousand one hundred only) contributed to the funds of the said trust by the Settler is held by the Trustees for the purpose of the said Trust.
- D) Such sums or assets as may be contributed, gifted, donated or bequeathed hereafter by the Settler or by any person or persons, firm or company or by and State or Central Government or other authority to the said trust and shall include
- i) All interests or income arising out of the said sums and assets.

- ii) All assets that may be purchased or acquired from out of the said funds or otherwise acquired for the said Trust.
- iii) All investments and realizations there from out of the said funds and assets.
- iv) All sums and assets which have by any means become property of the Trust and
- v) The funds of the Trust shall be solely utilized towards the objects of the Trust and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to Trustees / Beneficiaries any sum by way of profits, interest, dividends etc.

E) Correspondence/Administrative Office:-The correspondence / administrative office of the trust shall be at H.No- D-11, Gali No-1, Panshil Colony, Part-2, Basantpur Village, Near Khajuri Masjid, PO-Tilpat, Faridabad, Haryana-121003 , which may be moved time to time to such other place or places as the trustees may deem fit and proper at their discretion.

3. Regular Meetings:-

A regular annual meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be held in the first quarter (April, May or June) of each year the day of which shall be called by the Chairperson. The Board of Trustees may provide the time and place for the holding of additional regular meetings with a notice.

4. JURISDICTION:-

The working area of the Trust shall be **all over India (National Level)**. The Trust may open and maintain branch offices in any state / union territories in India.

5. AIMS AND OBJECTS:-

The Aim: ANISHA CHARITABLE TRUST (ACT) wishes to take upon itself, the responsibility to educate the residents of

villages and townships. The Trust has been created for charitable purpose and main object of the TRUST shall be as defined here under;

1. 42. The Trust shall acquire by purchase, lease, gift, grant, legacy, bequest, exchange or otherwise from persons, company, government or institution, land building, motor vehicles and all other kinds of properties both movable and immovable for the attainment of the objects of the Trust. Also, to construct, improve, alter and expand any buildings that may be found necessary for the purpose of the Trust.
43. Strengthen the capacities of stake holders (men and women and social groups and communities) to make informed decisions with critical consciousness regarding the participation in planning and management of quality education and their socio-economic, cultural and political development of people in the affected areas within the broader framework of human rights and democratic ideas.
44. The Trust shall do all such things and perform all such legal acts as may be essential, useful or proper for the achievement of all or any objectives of the Trust.
45. The Trust shall run its activities on NO PROFIT NO LOSS BASIS AND NO part of its corpus or income shall be utilized for any purpose other than objectives described above.
46. To educate the people of their rights, duties in a democratic set up of the Trust.

47. The Trust shall receive funds from following sources from center/state governments:

- a. Local body grants, as recommended by the Central Finance Commission.
- b. Funds for implementation of centrally sponsored schemes.
- c. Funds released by the state governments on the recommendations of the State Finance Commissions.
- d. Funds released by the state/Center governments for various pension schemes, old age pension scheme in India

48. To appoint a State Finance Commission to make recommendations as regards to the financial powers of the Panchayats and to constitute a District Planning Committee to prepare a development plan draft for the district. The 3-tier system of Panchayati Raj consists:

- a. Village-level Panchayats.
- b. Block-level Panchayats
- c. District-level Panchayats.

49. The Trust shall make adequate arrangement and start / run rehabilitation centers for people who have been relocated from the core zones of tiger reserves to other parts, for their social / civil enlistment, as per Govt. rules.

50. The Trust shall assist, donate funds to charitable, social developmental bodies and may receive, accepts grants, gifts, endowment from other charitable institutions, union or state govt. philanthropic foundations and societies, with or without conditions for the fulfillment of the Trusts objectives.

51. Grant of donation to any Mosque, Church, Temple, Gurudwara and other places of worship or religious institutions. However, the Trust shall undertake religious activities.

52. The Trust shall apply for registration of patents and copyrights to protect intellectual property right for the products and services developed by the Trust by itself or in collaboration with others.
53. The Trust shall help the rural people in the tiger zone for socio-economic development by formation of self-help groups (SHGs), promotion of savings, thrift and credit activities, etc, as per Govt. rules. To developed Self Help Groups (SHG) of the "Below Poverty Line women".
54. The Trust shall enter in to contracts with the concerned authorities like, Municipal Committee, Education Department and such other Government / private agencies for the mid-day meals & other programs of school children or orphans in the tiger villages zone.
55. The Trust shall promote the interest of people in environment, sense of integration, self employment, family planning, making audio visual. Tele films, T.V. serials and documentary on various aspects of culture, music, crafts, environment, health, sports and place of social integration.

All the income, earning, moveable, immovable properties of the societies shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its aim and objects only set forth in the memorandum of association and no profit thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or in any manner whatsoever to the present and past members of the Trust or to any person claiming through any or more of the present or past member. No member of Trust shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immovable properties of the Trust or make any profit, whatsoever, by virtue of his membership.

10. TERM OF THE TRUSTEES:-

- i. The Trustees (who are the executors of this deed) may at any time after the creation of the Trust appoint one or more new Trustees. The Trustees so appointed shall have the same powers, rights and status of the executing Trustees. Such induction of new Trustees shall be approved by at least 2/3rd majorities. But in any case, the number of total trustees shall not exceed to seven. The Managing Trustees shall manage the funds, properties, assets and investments of the Trust. He /She shall attend to official correspondence, apply for and seek grants for projects, keep minutes of Board of Trustee's meeting, preparation of meeting, report, preparation of meeting agenda and circulation of notice meeting, memorandum, maintenance of accounts, overall management of Trust's Activities, project and institutions including appointments, supervision, dismissal of employees etc. He/ She shall have the right of

Alterations to the clauses of the Deed shall only be made at a meeting of the Trustees after giving notice of thirty days which notice shall be accompanied by details of the proposed alterations and shall be subject to confirmation at a second meeting of the Trustees held not earlier than twenty days after the first meeting. Clauses may be altered by the votes of 2/3rd of the number of the Trustees. All alterations shall be confirmed by a Deed of Variation of Trust. No amendments to the Trust deed shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of Sec. 2 (15), 11, 12 and 13 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 amended from time to time.
